It's with a strong sense of pride that one of our long-standing Directors, Trevor Bange, was recognised with a Medal of the Order of Australia (OAM) as part of the 2022 Queen's Birthday honours.

Whilst Trevor has been an RAAus Board member since 2013, his contribution to aviation goes way back to his teenage years, when he went solo in a glider at 15 years of age and then started instructing early in his 20's. In more recent times Trevor has been the Chief Flying Instructor of Lone Eagle Flight School in Clifton, QLD, a role he has volunteered for since his retirement as a Psychiatric Nurse within the Queensland medical system in 2002.
